1) Title of the practice:

Frequent blood donors ensure that blood is readily collected and tested and available whenever it is needed.

4) The practice:-

We organized blood donation camps at least once in a year coming last five years apart from the Lockdown period of Covid-19 Blood Donation Camp was organized by college Y. R. C. and N. S. S. Units in Association with Athani Blood Bank on 1st February 2023.

The initiation taken by Dr. Shrivatsa Kulkarni and Dr. Vijaykumar Chaini. 69 students and staff members donated their blood.

5) Evidence of success:-

- Blood donation camps have been organized in the college once every year.
- During the year 2022-23 more than 69 students including staff members donated their blood.
- The donor students, faculty get free health checkups in identifying the pulse rate, blood pressure, body temperature, blood group and hemoglobin level.
- The seek student get proper medical advice from the health personnels

6) Problems encountered:-

- Students are much phobic to needles and blood testing.
- Some students are underweight and anemic due to malnutrition and undernourishment
- Lack of parental support for blood donation
- Some students have ignorance about the health status

7) Resource required:-

- An expert team of doctors and nurses from government or private hospitals.
- Different blood collection organizations and NGOS
- Infrastructure like furniture, Blood testing rooms, Blood donation rooms.
- Blood testing equipment, tools, and other required materials.
- Active and devoted students, staff.

Title of the Practice

KHADI DAY

Objectives of the Practice :

The main objective behind the implementation of Khadi dress in our institute is to inculcate a sense of patriotism and love for our own culture in students and staff. Though Khadi is remembered as a fabric of freedom, it is still perceived as unfashionable by many especially youth. Therefore, this attempt has been made to discover the awareness about Khadi among college youth and also to promote Khadi as a fashion fabric. This practice is made to develop national integrity and aware the students about freedom fight movements and role of Khadi culture at that movement.

The Context :

Acceptance of Khadi as fashion fabric by well known fashioners has forced institute to take note of khadi fabric as uniform for all the members of institute including students, teaching and non-teaching staff. The main challenging issues considered here is Khadi was meant to be a supplementary industry to agriculture, a crucial element in a self sustaining economy. It greatly supports the rural artisans to earn their livelihood; thus strengthening the rural economy. Our city Athani experiences maximum temperature during summer and cold climate during winter season hence, khadi keeps wearer warm in winter as well as cool in summer season. Therefore, Khadi uniform was introduced by the board of management by consulting the head of the institution.

The Practice :

Along with academic studies, students should be aware of various small scale industries such as Khadi, silk, agriculture industry and their role in Indian economy. A country remains poor in wealth both materially and intellectually, if it does not develop its handicraft and its industries and lives a lazy parasitic life by importing all the manufactured articles from outside. Therefore, it is an attempt made to support the development of Khadi industry and agriculture. This practice was adopted by the due recommendation of IQAC based on the suggestions given by the stake holders.


The students and staff need to wear Khadi dress on every Thursday. It was initially difficult to implement, because readymade dress supply for all the students was not possible but later board of management has called garment agent and kept Khadi Exhibition. This practice created healthy environment among the students and teachers in the campus.

Evidence of Success :

This Khadi Fabric practice has brought tremendous change among the students. This unique practice of Khadi created happiness and equality among students and staff. Moreover students and staff enthusiastically purchase Khadi Fabric.

Problems Encountered and Resources Required :

The Khadi uniform for all the staff members was introduced to develop national integrity and to support Khadi industry. But it was bit difficult to implement because compared to other fabrics Khadi is costlier.
